

Oregon Skid Steer 3.27.2016

On Easter Sunday March 27th, subjects arrived at a fuel station expansion project at the Fred Meyer, [35885 Industrial Way](#), Sandy, Oregon, engaged with the attendant, then loaded and stole the below described Case Skid Steer.

This is another example of thieves targeting older equipment, which has been considered less vulnerable to theft due to its age and marketability. This incident is a reminder to both the industry and Law Enforcement that any age of equipment should be considered a potential theft target.

Pictured is a similar Case 75-XT with standard bucket. The stolen machine was also open cab.

The machine Product Identification Number plate is below the seat.

The ROPS serial number plate is also inside the cab, to the right of the operator, and must not be confused as the machine identification - the ROPS serial only identifies the roll cage.
